Scope

This research policy serves as the basis of ethical research carried out by the institution and serves as guidelines for the functioning of the Research and Development Cell of Bikali College.

Custodian of the Policy

The implementation of the policy is carried out by the Research and Development Cell, Bikali College. The cell plays a pivotal role in catalysing research especially interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary research in Bikali College as mandated in NEP, 2020.

Objectives of the Research Policy

- To promote awareness regarding research and innovation among the faculty members and students of Bikali College
- To establish a healthy research environment where researchers work with integrity, honesty, avoiding plagiarism, falsification and fabrication.
- To establish research centres in different disciplines in the college with emphasis on the social relevance and social utility of the project.
- To encourage the faculty members as well as students to write research papers in UGC
 Care Listed and SCOPUS listed journals.
- To encourage faculty members to undertake research projects
- To publish a research journal
- To create awareness in the society through various research initiatives

Research Policy

- 1. To encourage authentic and original research in different disciplines and fields of study.
- 2. To identify the emerging areas of research and encourage the faculty members to undertake research in these areas.
- 3. To establish linkage with industries and local institutions to identify potential areas of research, surveys and other basic research enquiry.
- 4. To encourage faculty members to get research projects from National Funding agencies like UGC, ICSSR, etc as well as state government fundings.
- 5. To identify faculty members with doctorates who can work as leaders in the field of research and encourage them to undertake research projects.
- 6. To provide financial assistance for the publication of books, research papers and research findings.
- 7. To offer a suitable platform to the faculty members and students to publish their research.
- 8. To encourage the faculty members and students to undertake research on the burning issues of the local society with an objective of making policy interventions.
- 9. To organize various workshops to develop appropriate research skills among the students and faculty members.

- 10. To encourage faculty members to various seminars, workshops and conferences and provide them with financial support if required.
- 11. To establish suitable infrastructure and environment in the college that will help to undertake different research projects.
- 12. To enhance data resource available in the college to make the institution space more suitable for undertaking quality research projects.
- 13. To undertake all other such activities which will inculcate research culture in the college.
