

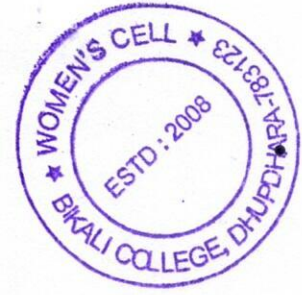

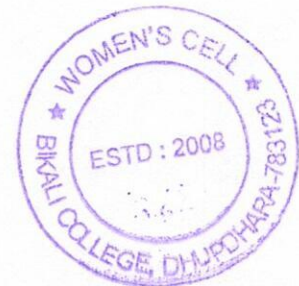

- iii. To provide advice on self-care during pregnancy.







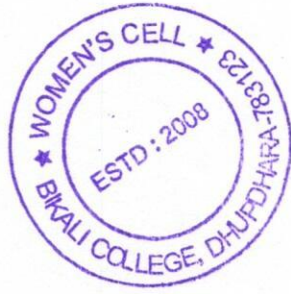
- To create consciousness about how to prevent infection during pregnancy and prevent injury to both mother and baby.
- v. To educate the mother and family members about the importance of proper care, and nutrition to the children.
  - vi. To make the guardians aware about the student's safety and security of children.

**Particulars of the Programme:** An awareness programme on “Maternal and Child Health” was held by the Women’s Cell of Bikali College at Kalitapara Dhupdhara. Ms Trishna Das, a nurse, at Bikali Model Hospital, was the resource person of the programme. The objective of the programme was to make aware of maternal health and how to take care of herself during this period. What should be the proper age for pregnancy how to confirm it the procedure for medical registration how to maintain and continue the medicine during this period she explained all these things in detail. She talked about the various do’s and don’ts during this period and advised women to be mentally and physically strong. In her lecture, she also addressed maternal nutrition, childbirth education, and managing potential complications related to pregnancy and childbirth. She later discussed what happens after childbirth and how to take care of the newborn child, the importance of regular medical checkups, the importance of regular vaccination of the newborn and the importance of carrying an MCP card while going for vaccination. She also discussed about the probable health related issues of newborn and what should be the treatment and initiative of the parents of the child.

**OUTCOMES OF THE PROGRAMME:** The programme was found to be a very fruitful one.

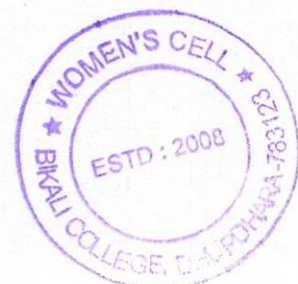


**Name of the activity:** Quiz Competition on Current Affairs

### **Particulars of the programme:**

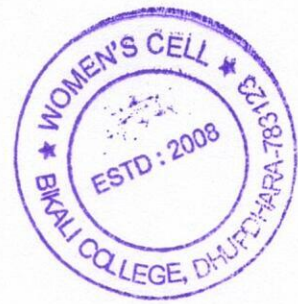

Ms. Jitamoni Das, an advocate discussed the various government schemes that are related to women and girl children and also fundamental and constitutional rights associated with women and girl children. Ms. Das was also aware of legal rights related to marriage and divorce, domestic abuse, and menstrual hygiene and sanitation.

- i. Participants availed individual counselling from resource person Jitamoni Das regarding the legal rights of a girl child and how to overcome the hurdles faced when they wanted their daughter to go to school.

## **Activity 1**

**Title: Awareness Programme on the Constitution of India**

**Date: 26/11/2018**

**Type of activity: Extension Activity**

**Venue: Simlabari, Anchalik High School, Simlabari, Goalpara**

**Total Number of Participants: 59**

An awareness programme on constitutional values was held on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2018 at Simlabari Anchalik School in Goalpara district. The coordinator of the programme was Kabir Hussain, Assistant Professor, Bikali College. The activity involved a lecture on Fundamental Rights and Directive Principles of State Policy (DPSP) of the Constitution of India. The programme was designed to instill knowledge of the Indian Constitution and its inherent values primarily, those of Liberty, Equality and Fraternity among the students of Simlabari Anchalik school.

### **Objectives:**

- i. To provide students with knowledge of the history of the promulgation of the Constitution of India
- ii. To provide students with insights on the Preamble, different Articles, Schedules and Amendments of the Constitution of India
- iii. To enhance their understanding of the functioning of the Constitution
- iv. To enhance students' understanding of their rights and duties as enshrined in the Fundamental Rights and Directive Principles of State Policy
- v. To inculcate values of liberty, equality, fraternity, justice among the students.

The programme was initiated by headmaster-in-charge of Simlabari Anchalik school, Shri Shahinur Islam who introduced the speaker from Bikali College and set the agenda of the event. He emphasized the need to understand the Constitution of the land to know the rights of the citizens.

Kabir Hussain, Assistant Professor, Bikali College made his presentation on the values of the Constitution as enshrined in the Preamble, Fundamental Rights and discussed Articles relevant to the students primarily Article 21(A) i.e. Right to Education. Mr. Hussain also emphasized the rights of the girl child and the importance of their education. He addressed the prevalent evil of early marriage especially of the girl child and added that educating the girl child could act as a panacea to the problem of early marriage and associated ills. He concluded his speech with emphasis on young citizens' knowing and imbibing the values inherent in the Constitution of India, without which the progress of the Indian state and society would remain stunted.

Thereafter, Assistant Teacher, Khairul Islam spoke about the Fundamental Duties of the Indian citizens such as respecting the national emblem, anthem and other symbols of the land. He also added preserving the environment, promoting harmony and brotherhood while also fighting superstitions and developing scientific temperament should be inculcated among young students for the betterment of the country.

### **Feedback:**

Feedback from participating teachers, students and parents was overwhelmingly positive.

- The teachers appreciated the Department of Political Science, Bikali College for taking initiative to disseminate understanding and values of the Constitution of India among the school fraternity. The head teacher added that the programme had created a bridge between the school and HEIs such as Bikali College and they looked forward to more such initiatives on the part of the college in the near future.
- A parent Shri Fakhruddin Ahmed added that such initiative by Bikali College would create aspiration among the students to attend colleges. He appreciated the college greatly for taking such a welcome step in light of huge dropouts among the students and lack of understanding of the importance among many parents.
- The students thanked the Department of Political Science, Bikali College for giving them a clear and concise understanding of the Preamble and Article 21(A).

Thereafter, Assistant Teacher of Simlabari Anchalik School, Shri Javed Ali proposed the vote of thanks and thanked Bikali College, the school authority, participating parents and students for the successful conduct of the programme.

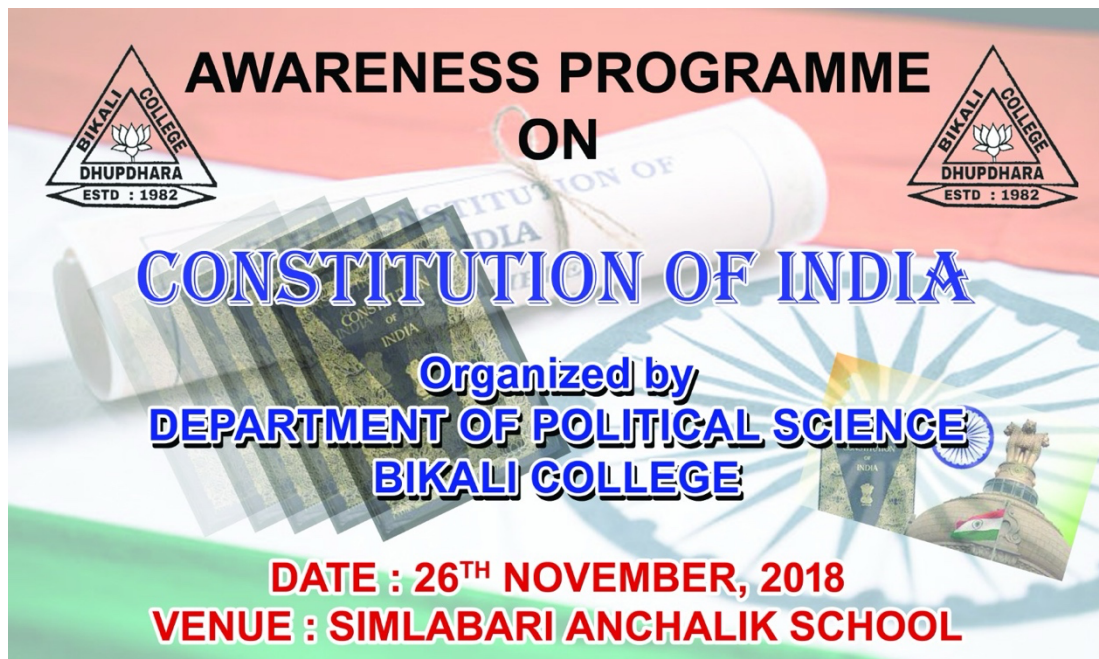


Figure 1 Flex Banner of the Extension Programme

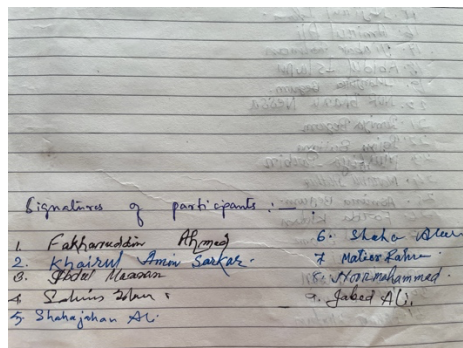


Figure 4 Signatures of Faculty participants

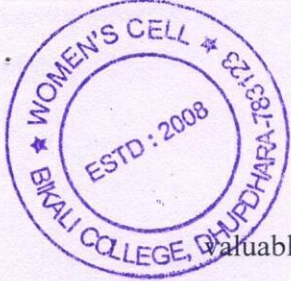
**Objectives of the Programme:**

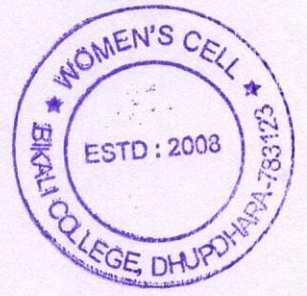
