

- To make the students familiar with different kinds of sentences

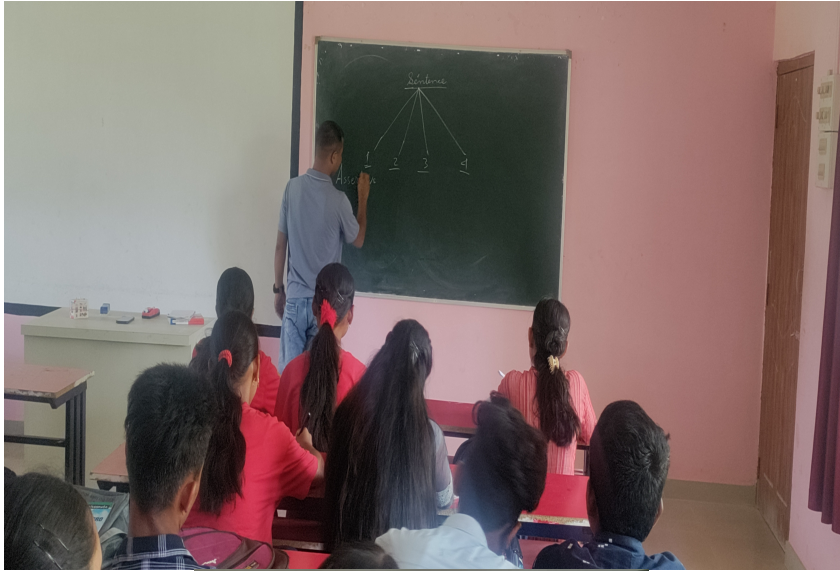
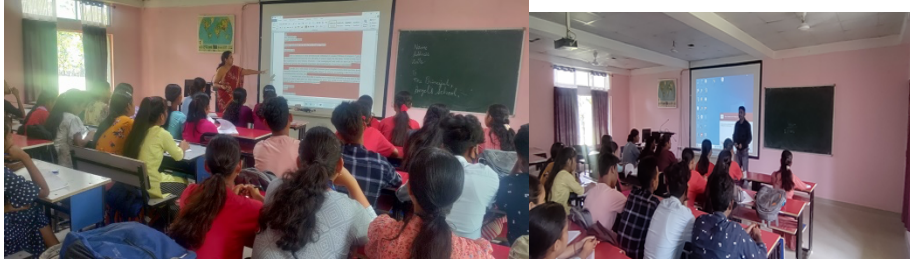
As per the resolution taken in the departmental meeting, a two day outreach programme for High School students on Basic English Grammar was organized on 19th and 20th August, 2019. Three sessions of one hour each per day was conducted. The topics taught are as follows:

1. Parts of speech
2. Sentence structure
3. Tense
4. Determiners
5. Preposition
6. Letter and report writing

The students showed keen interest in the classes and cleared some of their doubts.

The students were drawn towards the concepts of grammar. They also gained basic knowledge regarding structuring of sentences. Doubts were cleared during the interaction at the end of each class. As per the resolution three classes were taken on the first day and four sessions were taken on the second day owing to the interest shown by the students. 30 participants attended the programme.






