Moreover, it has also been seen that the girl child does not have any say about their marriage and choices to choose their partner for life as it is a patriarchal society where women and girl children are naturally considered homemakers. It is also being found that women's education is not given much importance as they are considered a family burden.




Figure 1 Requisition for the Outreach Programme




Figure 2 Notice for the Outreach Programme

Introduction:

The Department of Political Science is signatory to a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Kathakuthi Gaon Panchayat, located in Kathakuthi, Goalpara district. The MOU was signed with the primary objective of imparting a hands-on understanding of grassroots democracy among the students of Political Science. Furthermore, the study of Panchayat system is also part of the curriculum as given in Paper POL SE 4014 (Panchayati Raj in Practice). The department was in discussion with the incumbent Panchayat president Shri Utpal Rabha, who also happens to be an alumna of Bikali College to impart students firsthand understanding of the powers, functions and responsibilities of the Gaon Panchayats. Shri Rabha also expressed that the Department of Political Science sheds light and provides insights among the village denizens on the theoretical discourses prevalent in the Panchayati system. Therefore, the department in collaboration with the Kathakuthi Panchayat came to jointly organize an awareness programme on Panchayati Raj and Local Democracy on the occasion of National Panchayat Day, 2023 at the panchayat office. The programme would benefit the students as well as the panchayat residents.

Objectives:

- To provide the students with hands-on learning experience
- To enhance students' understanding of real-world applications of the theories of local democracy as taught in the paper Panchayati Raj in Practice.
- To create awareness among the Kathakuthi Panchayat residents on the importance of local democracy
- To share insights among the village residents on the current debates concerning praxis of local self-government and its strengths and weaknesses
- To encourage creativity and critical thinking among the students through discussion with practitioners of Panchayati Raj and vice versa

The programme was coordinated by Dr. Prasanta Chakrakrabarty, Head, Department of Political Science and Rakhee Naiding, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science alongside Utpal Rabha, President, Kathakuthi Gaon Panchayat.

A total of 44 students participated in the awareness programme cum field study at the Kathakuthi Gaon Panchayat. A total of 6 Panchayat functionaries including the President and 23 residents of Kathakuthi village participated in the programme. It was held on 24th April, 2023 which is commemorated as National Panchayat Day.

The programme was introduced by Rakhee Naiding who announced the agenda of the event. She briefly spoke about the history of the commemoration of National Panchayat Day and its importance. Thereafter she invited Dr. Chakrabarty to deliver his address on the theme "Importance and Relevance of Local Self Government to strengthen Democracy". Dr Chakrabarty covered the history of local self-government from the Mahajanapadas of ancient India to the introduction of local self-rule during colonial rule. He emphasized on the Gandhian concept of Gram Swaraj followed by the 73rd Amendment which forms the bedrock of the present panchayati raj system. He also highlighted the enhanced role of the present-day citizen in strengthening the local democracy. Furthermore, the concept of e-governance was also discussed which further made services accessible to a greater number of citizens furthering the cause of democracy. Dr. Chakrabarty ended his address with a caution to the audience to be vigilant about their role and responsibilities in the panchayat system, without which the democratic fabric of the country could unravel.

Thereafter, the panchayat president briefly spoke about the history of Kathakuthi panchayat and shed light on the number of houses, amenities in the village. He also spoke about the recent tasks carried out by the panchayat for the development of the village.

The students raised their questions on the bottlenecks, if any, in the functioning of the Kathakuthi Gaon Panchayat and the panchayat system in general.

One student raised a query on why the approach road from Bikali College to the Kathakuthi Panchayat was still a mud road and no construction was visible.

Another student raised her query on the status of the social audit and why the panchayat's website did not host the latest social audit reports.

The programme continued with a healthy discussion and brainstorming among the students, panchayat functionaries and the residents of the Kathakuthi Panchayat present.

The students also interacted further with the individual residents present and studied bookkeeping, schemes in process, and record maintenance procedures at the panchayat.

The programme ended with a vote of thanks proposed by Rakhee Naiding who profusely thanked the Panchayat for giving the students their valuable time and resources which had greatly enriched their understanding of the panchayati raj system. She thanked Dr. Chakrabarty on enlightening the audience on the theoretical aspects of the Panchayat system and current debates. She thanked all participants for their time, patience and ideas in making the program a grand success and added that the Department of Political Science looked forward to more such programmes in the future.

Outcomes:

- A total of 44 students participated and successfully completed their SEC paper POL SE 4014 (Panchayati Raj in Practice) with first-hand experience of the panchayat raj system
- The students gained practical knowledge of the machinations of the Kathakuthi Gaon Panchayat which deepened their understanding of how a panchayat functions in realtime outside their classrooms and textbooks
- The programme created an increased and healthy engagement between the Department of Political Science and the residents of Kathakuthi village.
- Students developed essential life skills such as critical thinking, problem-solving and communication.
- The participants from the Kathakuthi village learned about the essence of local selfrule, its history, current processes and its continuing relevance in the larger democratic arena.




Figure 8 Dr. P. Chakrabarty delivering his speech on the current discourse on Panchayati raj

Objective of the program: To provide health assessment and awareness to the villagers on non-communicable diseases.

On 6th May, the Bikali College Extension Cell and NSS Unit collaborated with Bikali Model Hospital to organize a health check-up camp on non-communicable diseases in Adarshapara village.
