

**NOTIFICATION**

No. AHSEC/EXB/NOTIFICATION/2022/336 : It is hereby notified for information of all intending and eligible candidates who are desirous of appearing in the HS Final Examination, 2024 under following categories:-

- a) *Under Betterment Scheme/Re-appearance Scheme.*
- b) *As Teacher / Female / Defense Personnel Private candidates.*
- c) *In certain subject/subjects*
- d) *MIL subject permission not taught in the Institution.*

**(A) (i) UNDER BETTERMENT SCHEME / RE-APPEARANCE SCHEME**

A student who passed the HS Final Examination, 2023 for the first time and is intending to appear in the ensuing HS Final Examination, 2024 under the **Betterment Scheme / under Re-appearance Scheme** should apply online along with the regular candidates of the HS Final Examination, 2024. They are not required to avail prior permission from the Council in this regard, but, the prescribed permission fees are to be paid during the time of online form fill up.

Such students desirous of appearing in the Betterment of Result Scheme will be allowed to appear in maximum 4 (four) subjects only of his/her combination of subjects offered in the HS Final Examination, 2023 (Arts/Science/Commerce/Vocational Streams). **Students appearing under Betterment of Result Scheme must appear in Practical Examination also if subject(s) contain(s) Practical Paper(s).**

Higher marks if secured by a candidate in subject/subjects under the Betterment of Result Scheme in the HS Final Examination, 2024 then the mark(s) of the subject/subjects of the previous HS Final Examination, 2023 would be replaced in the new mark-sheets retaining the other marks as it is. Only one mark-sheet will be issued to a candidate under this Betterment of Result Scheme on surrendering the previous mark-sheet.

***In conformity with the guidelines of the CBSE, candidates who passed the HS Examination 2023 and wish to improve upon their performance to attain the eligibility criteria for admission in Engineering, Medical, etc. through competitive examination, they shall be allowed to reappear in all subjects, (he/she appeared in the last examination) under Reappearance scheme and their better result will be taken into account. Under no circumstances Better Mark obtained in single or any subject will be added with the previous result.*** In respect of all competitive Examinations, the Candidates will decide before applying whether he/she will appear under Betterment chance or Re-appear in the Examination. Students appearing under Reappearance Scheme must have to appear in Practical Examinations also if subject(s) having Practical Paper(s).

**(B) TEACHER/FEMALE/DEFENSE PERSONNEL PRIVATE CANDIDATES**

- (i) Candidates who on being accorded permission by the Council to appear as Teacher/Female/Defense Personnel Private candidates in the HS First Year Examination, 2023 (Arts stream only with subject without practical parts) and passed the said examination will have to obtain permission from the Council for appearing in the HS Final Examination, 2024 (Arts Stream). They are also required to register their names in the Council before appearing in the HS Final Examination, 2024 (Arts Stream).
- (ii) A candidate belonging to any of the following categories may be admitted to the H. S. Final Examination in Arts stream with subject (s) having no practical papers without prosecuting a regular course of study in an institution as a Non-institutional private candidate, on fulfillment of the conditions noted against each :

**(a) FEMALE CANDIDATE :**

She must pass the H. S. First year Examination after a lapse of at least one academic year from the year of passing the HSLC Examination.
