




Action Taken Report (2021-2022)

1. Online coaching successfully completed on NET/SLET coordinated by Career Counselling and Guidance Cell with resource persons from CSAP, Guwahati.
2. Total of 50 students completed the Certificate Course on Digital Marketing conducted by IQAC in collaboration with ICT Academy.
3. Webinars by different departments conducted successfully during the lockdown and reports submitted to IQAC by each department.
4. The IQAC conducted counselling for newly admitted students during the 1st week of October on Code of Conduct, CBCS syllabi, Skill Enhancement Courses, Anti-ragging rules, Grievance Redressal mechanism and facilities provided in the college.
