




How would you rate the support and assistance provided by the college office staff? 569 responses




How would you rate the support and assistance provided to resolve your grievances related to examination, admission, facilities etc?














How would you rate the organisation of various co-curricular activities such as sports, cultural, literary activities, NSS/NCC etc?






How would you rate the student participation and involvement in organising any of these activities? 569 responses








Integration of ICT in teaching-learning 569 responses



Teachers preparation for class with learning material and inputs 569 responses




Teachers' capacity to make the class interesting through illustration and examples 569 responses




Participative and discussion-based teaching-learning strategies





The IQAC, Bikali College under the leadership of IQAC Coordinator, Dr. Rakhee Naiding carried out its annual students' feedback collection on curriculum, teaching-learning resources, services and infrastructure. A total of 569 students from UG and PG (both CBCS and FYUGP) participated in the process.

Key Observations from Student Responses:

1. Curriculum Organization and Clarity

- o A large majority agreed the curriculum is well organized and easy to follow.
- Students seem to understand the academic structure effectively, indicating strong academic planning.

2. Course Choices and Electives

While many agreed that the curriculum offers sufficient choices, there was a significant percentage of neutral responses, indicating that students may be unaware of all options or want more diversified choices.

3. Knowledge Creation

Most students agree the syllabus helps in building a strong knowledge base,
 suggesting its relevance to foundational understanding.

4. Job-Oriented Skill Development

- A noticeable dip in agreement appears when asked if the syllabus helps in gaining job-ready skills.
- Suggests a need to integrate more employability-linked components (e.g., internships, project-based learning).

5. Entrepreneurial Orientation

The feedback shows **mixed responses**, with many students **neutral or disagreeing**, highlighting a **gap in entrepreneurship development** in the curriculum.

6. Creative Thinking and Innovation

While many students felt that the syllabus encourages creative thinking, the responses were somewhat divided, suggesting that more innovation-oriented tasks/projects may be needed.

Recommendations

• Introduce Choice-Based Courses (CBCS) more widely with electives linked to local

livelihood, technology, and entrepreneurship.

• Integrate job-oriented training like soft skills, career counselling, and industry visits

into the curriculum.

Include entrepreneurship development modules, especially targeting rural and regional

startup opportunities.

• Encourage problem-solving assignments, hackathons, and innovation challenges for

all semesters.

Ensure students are aware of elective options and their outcomes through orientation

sessions.
