Section-wise Analysis

1. Curriculum Relevance & Structure

- Q1: "The syllabus is relevant to your academic and career goals."
- Q2: "The curriculum reflects current trends and recent developments in the subject."
- **Q3:** "Courses are well-structured with clear learning outcomes."
- **Q4:** "Interdisciplinary or skill-based courses are included in the curriculum."
- **Q5:** "Curriculum provides sufficient opportunities for value-based education (ethics, gender, environment, etc.)"

Observations:

High positive responses for relevance, with room to improve skill-based and value-oriented components.

Recommendations:

- Introduce more practical modules and soft skill workshops.
- Enhance interdisciplinary electives aligned with NEP 2020.

2. Teaching Quality & Planning

- **Q6:** "The curriculum is effectively taught by your teachers."
- **Q7:** "ICT tools and online resources are used during the teaching-learning process."
- Q13: "Teaching plans and course schedules are communicated in advance."

Observations:

Teaching quality is appreciated, though use of ICT can improve.

Recommendations:

- Continue faculty development programmes.
- Monitor and encourage ICT-based teaching via LMS or smart boards.

3. Infrastructure and Learning Resources

- **Q8:** "The college provides adequate learning resources (books, labs, internet, etc.) to support the curriculum."
- **Q9:** "Opportunities are provided to undertake field projects, internships, or research related to the curriculum."

Observations:

Students expect improved access to internet, labs, and practical exposure.

Recommendations:

- Upgrade library and ICT labs.
- Increase collaborations with local industries for field-based learning.

4. Assessment and Communication

• Q14: "Internal exams are fair, timely, and processes are communicated properly."

Observations:

Generally satisfactory, but need for timely information dissemination.

Recommendations:

• Use ERP and digital notice systems to streamline exam communication.

5. Qualitative Suggestions

- Q15 & Q16: Students proposed curriculum updates and introduction of courses. Students have suggested courses such as academic writing, research ethics, Media Literacy and Fake News Awareness, Healthcare, Psychology, General Studies and Current Affairs, Leadership courses, Data Entry, Hindi, Philosophy, etc
- The students also expressed dissatisfaction with the lack of TLM of the FYUGP common courses. Students' also requested books on AI in the library.








Semester 127 responses


