The outcomes of the Certificate Course in Sanskrit Language:

- Study and practice of simple Sanskrit conversation.
- Proficiency in day-to-day Sanskrit conversation.
- Introduction to the basic structure of Sanskrit language.
- Familiarity with Sanskrit vocabulary and gradual build-up of new words in Sanskrit.
- Provision of pictorial study materials (Prathama Deeksha)

The students who complete the Certificate Course successfully will be eligible to undertake the Diploma in Sanskrit Language.

Eligibility for Admission:

Anyone, above the age of fifteen, who is curious to learn Sanskrit, is eligible to take admission in "Certificate Course in Sanskrit Language".

The admission is open for all the students, teachers, employees and officers of the concerned institution and also family members and general public.

Admission process:

The admission process will be done through Samarth portal. For this, learners have to register through this link <https://csucsl.samarth.edu.in> after which they have to select the intended course and pay the fees of Rs. 1500/- through online portal.

Steps:

Step 1 : Registration

Step 2 : Filling all the details of learner

Step 3 : Programme and Centre Selection

Step 4 : Documents uploading.

Step 5 : Fees payment and final submission.

Examination:

The examination is conducted by Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi in May/June annually through online mode. The marksheet and certificates will be distributed to the successful learners.

Learners who are unsuccessful or absent in the examination may deposit the examination form along with the examination fee to appear in the next year.

Annual Examination through online mode.

The learners of the Centre for Sanskrit Learning will be given two chances to pass the examination in two consecutive years only, starting from the Academic year of enrolment, for example, the learner enrolled in the academic year 2024- 25 will be entitled to appear in the Annual Examinations in 2025 or 2026 only.
